TIMED ONLINE BIDDING (Automatic)

This Clearing Sale will be conducted by Timed Online Only Auction. It will run automatically with No Auctioneer and No Audio.

If you are not already a registered bidder, you must register to bid online - Please register before midday on day of sale

Pre-bidding is available for 5 days and then, at the advertised time, the webcast will commence automatically, with no audio.

You can continue bidding during this time.

If you have set an Autobid, the system will continue to bid on your behalf, up to your maximum, but only if there are competitive bids against you.

Autobids will be given priority over manual bids of the same value.

During the Final Bidding, Lot 1 will begin to close. A countdown clock for that lot is displayed.

Any bids in the last 20 seconds will reset the countdown clock back to 20 seconds, to allow more bidding.

The countdown clock will reset to display how much time until that lot closes.

Each lot has its own countdown clock. Each lot is scheduled to close 30 seconds after the previous lot, subject to active bidding.

Lots will close in consecutive order.

A simple way to have control of your bidding is to use the Autobid or Maximum Bid feature, well in advance of the closing time.

Once set, the system will bid for you up to your maximum, but only if there are competitive bids against you.
